

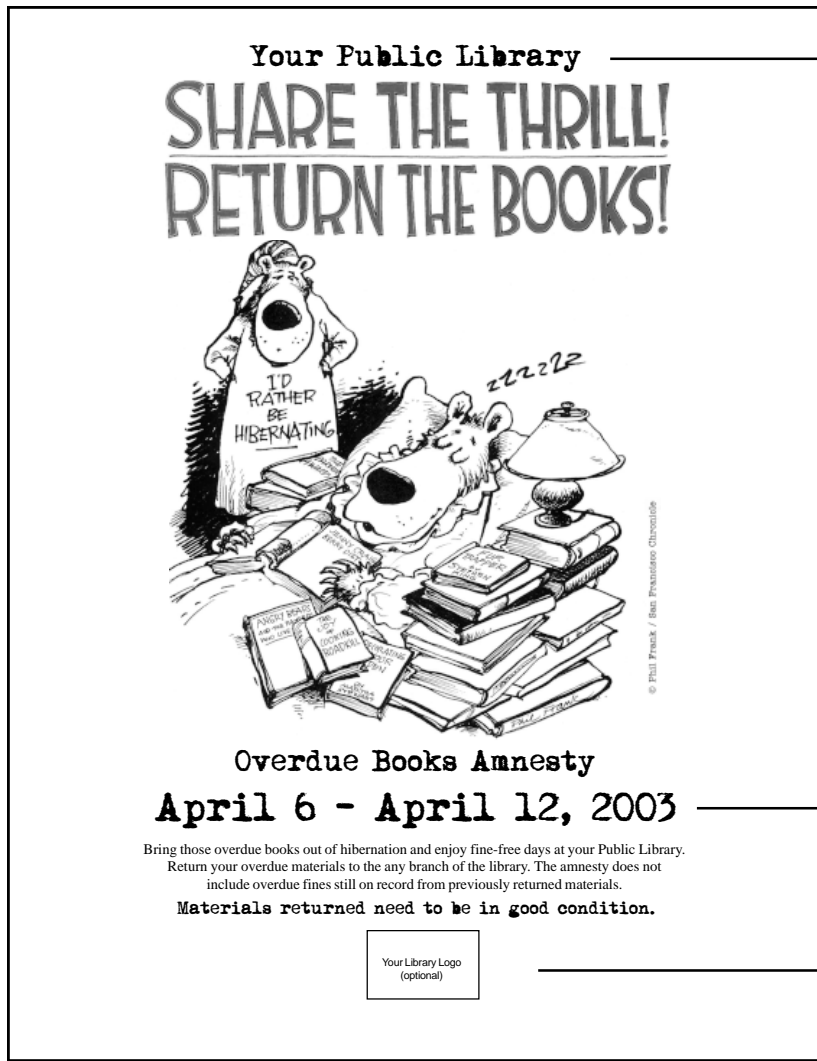
Flyer Customizing Instructions

First, print the next page of this document onto a piece of white paper using a good laser or ink jet printer.

Then use the provided TrueType font, Mom's Typewriter, to typeset the custom additions to the flyer in your Word processor. Print the typeset elements on a piece of white paper using a good laser printer.

Then cut the elements out so that each element is on its own little scrap of paper. Then use a glue stick or spray glue to paste the element in the appropriate places on the flyer. Copy as many as you want onto colorful paper.

That's all there is to it.



Put the name of your library here in Mom's Typewriter – 20pt. – centered.

Put the dates of your campaign here in Mom's Typewriter – 27pt. – centered.

If you have clean artwork of your library's logo in the right size, paste it here.

Remember, it's your flyer. Feel free to change anything you want to change in order to make the design your own. If you want to change the promotional copy, just typeset new copy in the same manner as you have done with the other elements (the existing copy is Times Roman 11pt.) and paste it over the existing copy.
